

A Look at the 1,260 Days in Daniel, Matthew, and Revelation ¹

Revelation 11:1-3: The two witnesses are to prophesy 1,260 days (3 1/2 years). Revelation 12:6: The woman is to be fed for 1,260 days (3 1/2 years). Revelation 12:14: The woman will be nourished for a time, and times, and half a time (3 1/2 years). Daniel 7:25: Speaks of a time, times, and a dividing of time (3 1/2 years). Daniel 12:7: It shall be for a time, times, and a half (3 1/2 years). Revelation 13:5: *"it was given authority to act for forty-two months"* (3 1/2 years). The several times that this period is mentioned would indicate a definite period of three and one-half years. It is a reference to the Seventieth Week of Daniel.

The following chart will give a further indication how Daniel's Seventieth Week, the Olivet Discourse of Jesus and the general Outline of Revelation are correlated.
